# DON WILCOX Director of Bands West Virginia University

Don Wilcox has developed a close working relationship between the University and the West Virginia Community, while guiding the enthusiastic development of the bands at W V U to a combined enrollment of about 500 participants.

The seven active bands, which are housed in the \$ 12 million dollar Creative Arts Center, provide a variety of musical experiences ranging from the 300 member "Pride of West Virginia" marching band to a Wind Ensemble that has performed for national conferences of C B D N A and the M E N C.

Following graduation from the University of Michigan and eight years of public school instrumental music, Mr. Wilcox developed outstanding university programs in both California and Kansas before coming to West Virginia. He is active in numerous professional organizations including the College Band Directors National Association, National Band Association, Music Educators National Conference and the National Wind Ensemble Conference.

Mr. Wilcox has worked in more than 30 states with musicians of all ages and abilities, including conducting bands at summer music camps for the University of Michigan, University of Wisconsin, University of Illinois, University of Georgia, University of Arkansas, and at Interlochen, Michigan. His work with all-state bands, festival and honor groups has led to an active schedule throughout the nation as a clinician and guest conductor.
