State Auditions by President-Elect Sarah Sacco

Over the next few weeks you may be preparing your students and yourself for all-state band auditions, which can be a bit stressful to make sure you have done everything correctly. Here are some tips to help you make sure you and your students are prepared for the day!

- The registration window will be November 4 26, 2024, at 11:59pm.
- Registration website: <u>https://missouriallstateband.org/registration.php</u>
- The audition fee is \$15.00 per audition and you must pay for all students who have been registered.
 - PO's are NOT accepted
 - Cash or check can be paid before or on audition day
 - Credit cards must be processed before November 26th
- There will be a \$25.00 fee assessed to any late entry or correction in any part of the registration.
 - This fee will be assessed for each correction.
- On December 7, only directors/school representatives will need to check in.
 - You MUST have a school employee check in your student(s) and be on site during auditions
 - The director/school rep check-in will run from 8:30am
 11:00am
- The preliminary auditions will begin at 9:00am.
- Callbacks will be posted throughout the day using the students audition number
 - Once a student has completed their callback audition they are free to leave.
 - Not all instruments will have callback auditions.
- To achieve the highest possible score on scales, the SCALES MUST BE PERFORMED EXACTLY AS WRITTEN ON THE SCALE SHEET.
- Lastly, All the judges feel that a good audition is a good audition, whether it is at 9:00am or 1:00pm.
