

COMMANDER JOSEPH PHILLIPS
U. S. Navy

Commander Joseph Phillips, Head of the Navy Music Program, began his musical career on trombone at age 12. A native of Kannapolis, North Carolina, he enlisted in the Navy in 1957. After basic training and the basic music course at the Navy School of Music in Washington, D. C., he performed as an instrumentalist with the Commander, Naval Air Force Atlantic Band, Norfolk, Virginia. As a petty officer, his next two years were spent with the First Naval District Band in Boston. During that time, he studied trombone with John Coffey. He then returned to the School of Music faculty as a trombone instructor and rehearsal conductor. In May 1965, Chief Petty Officer Phillips reported to the staff of the Commander, Cruiser Destroyer Force, U. S. Pacific Fleet, San Diego, California, and went to sea as leader of Unit Band 108. Returning in 1967 to the School of Music in Norfolk, he served as audition supervisor until his promotion to Ensign in 1970. Since that time, he has been leader of the Commander-in-Chief Atlantic Fleet Band, Norfolk, and then assistant leader of the United States Naval Academy Band prior to becoming its leader in March 1973. Commander Phillips was awarded the Navy Commendation Medal for meritorious service rendered at the Academy. Commander Phillips then served as assistant leader of the United States Navy Band and later as Navy liaison officer in the Navy Office of Information, Washington, D.C. He then returned to the Navy Band as Officer in Charge and Musical Director from December 1978 to December 1984. Commander Phillips was awarded the Meritorious Service Medal for his leadership of the Navy's premier musical organization.

Commander Phillips is frequently guest conductor of all-state high school musical groups and college bands. In June 1979, he was guest Conductor of the famed Boston Pops Orchestra. Commander Phillips was voted a member of the prestigious American Bandmasters Association during the organization's 47th Annual Convention held in Washington, D.C. in April 1981. He is also the recipient of the Orpheus Award presented by the Phi Mu Alpha Sinfonia Fraternity. An avid sailor, the Commander regularly competes in one-design racing on the Chesapeake Bay in Annapolis, Maryland. He also enjoys flying and holds a commercial pilot's license.



Commander Joseph Phillips, Head of the Navy Music Program, began his musical career on trombone at age 12. A native of Kannapolis, North Carolina, he enlisted in the Navy in 1957. After basic training and the basic music course at the Navy School of Music in Washington, D. C., he performed as an instrumentalist with the Commander, Naval Air Force Atlantic Band, Norfolk, Virginia. As a petty officer, his next two years were spent with the First Naval District Band in Boston. During that time, he studied trombone with John Coffey. He then returned to the School of Music faculty as a trombone instructor and rehearsal conductor. In May 1965, Chief Petty Officer Phillips reported to the staff of the Commander, Cruiser Destroyer Force, U. S. Pacific Fleet, San Diego, California, and went to sea as leader of Unit Band 108. Returning in 1967 to the School of Music in Norfolk, he served as audition supervisor until his promotion to Ensign in 1970. Since that time, he has been leader of the Commander-in-Chief Atlantic Fleet Band, Norfolk, and then assistant leader of the United States Naval Academy Band prior to becoming its leader in March 1973. Commander Phillips was awarded the Navy Commendation Medal for meritorious service rendered at the Academy. Commander Phillips then served as assistant leader of the United States Navy Band and later as Navy liaison officer in the Navy Office of Information, Washington, D.C. He then returned to the Navy Band as Officer in Charge and Musical Director from December 1978 to December 1984. Commander Phillips was awarded the Meritorious Service Medal for his leadership of the Navy's premier musical organization.

Commander Phillips is frequently guest conductor of all-state high school musical groups and college bands. In June 1979, he was guest Conductor of the famed Boston Pops Orchestra. Commander Phillips was voted a member of the prestigious American Bandmasters Association during the organization's 47th Annual Convention held in Washington, D.C. in April 1981. He is also the recipient of the Orpheus Award presented by the Phi Mu Alpha Sinfonia Fraternity. An avid sailor, the Commander regularly competes in one-design racing on the Chesapeake Bay in Annapolis, Maryland. He also enjoys flying and holds a commercial pilot's license.
