Margery Deutsch - Conductor

About the Conductor

Since 1984, Margery Deutsch has been Director of Orchestras and Professor of Conducting at the University of Wisconsin-Milwaukee. An avid music educator, she frequently performs with her orchestra in schools and throughout the Milwaukee community and beyond.

Prior to coming to Milwaukee, Deutsch served as the Music Director of the Shreveport (Louisiana) Symphony, where her numerous duties included conducting subscription, chamber orchestra, pops, and children's concerts, as well as operas. Equally versed in orchestral and choral repertoire, she has served as Music Director of the Long Island Singers Society and, in Milwaukee, she has guest conducted the Master Singers, Bel Canto Chorus, Milwaukee Choristers, Lawrence University Choir, Milwaukee Children's Choir, and the Milwaukee Symphony Chorus.

Deutsch has been a frequent guest conductor for the Milwaukee Symphony Orchestra's Youth, Children's, and Family concert series. In addition, she has worked with the Women's Philharmonic (California), Plymouth (Michigan) Symphony, Dayton Philharmonic, Charleston (South Carolina) Symphony, Nebraska Sinfonia, Monroe (Louisiana) Symphony, South Dakota Symphony, and the all-state orchestras of Minnesota, Montana, Delaware, Maine, and Washington, as well as numerous district festivals throughout the country.

Deutsch has been conductor of the Milwaukee Youth Symphony Orchestra's Senior Symphony since January of 1987. She has conducted the orchestra in performances at the Wisconsin Music Educators Conference (North Central Division), the Midwest International Band and Orchestra Clinic, and the legendary Carnegie Hall. Deutsch and the orchestra were selected by famed bassist and author Barry Green (*The Inner Game of Music*) to serve as the demonstration orchestra in his series of ensemble workbooks and videotape. Under her direction, the Senior Symphony has toured Austria, France, Switzerland, Italy, Spain, Canada, and Scotland, where they performed as part of the Festival of British Youth Orchestras and the Edinburgh Festival. In June 2000, they were chosen as one of only five U.S. youth orchestras to participate in the National Youth Orchestra Festival in Sarasota, Florida. The group is recognized as one of the premiere youth orchestras in the country.

Deutsch is actively involved with high school-aged musicians throughout the country and is in frequent demand as a guest conductor and clinician. She recently completed serving her third term on the Board of Directors of the American Symphony Orchestra League's Youth Orchestra Division, which helps establish national policies for youth orchestras.

The recipient of numerous honors and awards, Deutsch received the 2001 Milwaukee Civic Music Association Award for Excellence in Contributions to Music, as well as the 1990 UWM Undergraduate Teaching Award. She has been awarded conducting fellowships and scholarships from the Aspen Music Festival, the Academia Chigiana in Siena, Italy, and the Nebraska-based "Festival of a Thousand Oaks." She was also invited to participate in the conducting seminar at Tanglewood, where she took masterclasses with Leonard Bernstein, Seiji Ozawa, and Colin Davis. Her other teachers include Thomas Briccetti, Franco Ferrarra, Bruno Bartoletti, Piero Bellugi, Sergiu Commisiona, and Dennis Russell Davies; she has also studied flute with Samuel Baron and voice with Jan DeGaetani. A native New Yorker and Regents Scholar, she holds a Master of Music degree in Orchestral Conducting, a Master of Arts degree in Musicology, and a Bachelor of Arts degree in Flute and Vocal Performance.

Dr. Jerry Blackstone - Conductor

About the Conductor

Jerry Blackstone is Director of Choirs and Chair of the Conducting Department at the University of Michigan School of Music, where he conducts the Chamber Choir, teaches conducting at the graduate and undergraduate levels, and administers a choral program of 11 choirs including the world acclaimed UM Men’s Glee Club. He also serves as Interim Conductor and Music Director of the University Musical Society Choral Union, a large community/university chorus that frequently appears with the Detroit Symphony Orchestra and presents yearly performances of Handel’s *Messiah*. Dr. Blackstone has conducted operatic productions with the University of Michigan Opera Theatre, and frequently prepares choirs for performances with the Detroit Symphony Orchestra under conductors Neeme Järvi, Nicholas McGegan, and Yitzak Perlman. In February 2003, the School of Music Chamber Choir presented three enthusiastically received performances in New York City at the National Convention of the American Choral Directors Association. Ever interested in working with young singers, Blackstone conducts the University of Michigan All-State High School Choir and Chamber Singers during the summer at the Interlochen Center for the Arts. During the academic year, he conducts the Michigan Youth Chamber Singers, an ensemble of highly-talented singers from throughout Michigan.

Conducting students of Dr. Blackstone have received first-place awards or been finalists in both the graduate and undergraduate divisions of the American Choral Directors Association’s biennial National Choral Conducting Awards competition. *U.S. News and World Report* recently rated the graduate conducting programs at the University of Michigan first in the nation. Santa Barbara Music Publishing recently released Dr. Blackstone’s educational video, *Working with Male Voices*, and also publishes the Jerry Blackstone Choral Series, a set of choral publications that presents works by several composers in a variety of musical styles.

Considered one of this country’s leading younger-generation choral conductors, Professor Blackstone has served as guest conductor from coast to coast, including recent all-state and workshop appearances throughout the country. Internationally he has performed in 12 foreign countries, including extensive concert tours throughout eastern and central Europe, Asia, and most recently, South America.

About the Conductor

David Holsinger joined the Lee University School of Music faculty in 1999 as associate professor in music. He holds degrees from Central Methodist College, Fayette, Missouri, and Central Missouri State University, Warrensburg. His post-graduate studies were at the University of Kansas, where he served under composer Charles Hoag. He also served as staff-arranger at KU and as high school band director in Lawson and Chillicothe, Missouri.

Twice Holsinger received the prestigious Ostwald Award for band composition, sponsored by the American Bandmasters Association. His compositions have won competitions sponsored by Kent State University and the National Federation of Music Clubs, as well as qualified as finalists in both the DeMoulin and Sudler competitions. Holsinger's compositions are played around the world and the Heritage Encyclopedia of Band Music sites the composer as a major voice in American band composition in the past two decades.

In 1995, Holsinger was honored by Gustavus Adolphus College in St. Peter, Minnesota, with the conferral of a Doctor of Humane Letters degree for lifetime achievement in composition, and the Gustavus Fine Arts Medallion, the division's highest award.

Holsinger resides in Cleveland, Tennessee, with his wife, Winona, a graduate of both Central Missouri State and the University of North Texas in wind studies and conducting. Mrs. Holsinger also teaches part-time in the Lee University School of Music. They have three children. Haven is pursuing a degree in Stage Management and Theatre Arts at the University of North Texas. Niles works for the Dallas Mavericks basketball team as part of the crowd entertainment crew, the "Funslingers," and also interns in the production and film editing department of DayStar Christian Television Network in Dallas, Texas. Grayson is a student at Lee University and a member of the university's soccer team.
