

Victor C. Johnson, a native of Dallas, Texas, is the School Choral Editor for Sing!, the educational publishing division of Choristers Guild. A prolific composer and arranger, he has over 450 choral works, vocal solo books, and keyboard collections currently in print. In addition to his work as a composer and editor, Victor serves as a conductor of the Dallas Symphony Children’s Chorus, which serve as the resident children’s chorus for Dallas Symphony Orchestra. Prior to his position at Choristers Guild and DSO, Victor was a choral director at Ft. Worth Academy of Fine Arts (FWAFA). At FWAFA, Victor directed the Academy Singers, Academy Men’s Choir and was Artistic Director of the Singing Girls of Texas and Children’s Choir of Texas. Victor is in demand as a guest conductor, adjudicator, and clinician for music educators and students throughout the United States. He has conducted All-State and Regional Honor choirs in the US and Canada. His own choirs have performed at the Texas Music Educators Association Convention as well as the American Choral Directors Association- Southwest Division conference. His professional affiliations include: American Choral Directors Association, Texas Music Educators Association, National Association for Music Education, Texas Choral Directors Association, ASCAP, and Phi Mu Alpha Sinfonia, Inc.

Cheryl Nichols has been making music with friends of all ages for fifty years. She has been a collaborative pianist with countless ensembles and soloists, and is an active member of the American Choral Directors Association. Serving ACDA, Cheryl has accompanied ACDA’s Missouri All State high school choir for 25 years. Ms. Nichols holds degrees from the University of Missouri-Columbia, and is a retired vocal music educator of 37 years. Cheryl is currently serving Columbia College as collaborative staff pianist and Peace United Church of Christ as director of choir and music in her hometown of Hartsburg, Missouri.

Emily Threinen is an Associate Professor of Music and serves as Director of Bands at the School of Music of the University of Minnesota-Twin Cities. In this position, she conducts the acclaimed University Wind Ensemble, guides the graduate wind band conducting program, and provides administrative leadership for all aspects of the University of Minnesota-TC Band Program. Threinen began this post in 2016. Prior to her appointment at Minnesota, Threinen served as Associate Professor, Director of Bands, and Artistic Director of Winds and Brass at Temple University’s Boyer College of Music and Dance in Philadelphia, Pennsylvania. Before her work in Philadelphia, Threinen served as Assistant Professor, Director of Bands at Shenandoah Conservatory of Shenandoah University in Winchester, Virginia; Director of the Duke University Wind Symphony in Durham, North Carolina; Director of the Concordia University Wind Ensemble in Ann Arbor, Michigan; Conductor of the Dodworth Saxhorn Band in Ann Arbor, Michigan; and Director of Bands and Instrumental Music at Harding High School in St. Paul, Minnesota, where she received the Outstanding Teacher Award.

Threinen consistently works with composers, arrangers, and performing artists of varied disciplines. Residencies, projects with composers, and new compositions are integral to her creative work. In addition to contributions in several articles, interviews, and books, Threinen has been published in multiple volumes of the GIA “Teaching Music Through Performance in Band” book series, where she has been recognized as a strong scholarly contributor. She is active across the nation and abroad (including work in Korea, Costa Rica, Australia, Spain, Brazil, and Canada), as a guest conductor, clinician, and conference presenter. Two highlights: Threinen served as a guest conductor and clinician for the U.S. Army Band “Pershing’s Own” Conductors Workshop in 2023 and Threinen served as the conductor for the National Association for Music Education All-National High School Concert Band at the National Conference in Orlando, Florida in 2019. Threinen is a strong advocate for music education and is proud to serve as a Yamaha Master Educator. She is an active member of these organizations: American Bandmasters Association (ABA), World Association for Symphonic Band and Ensembles (WASBE), College Band Directors National Association (CBDNA), Big Ten Band Directors Association, National Band Association (NBA), National Association for Music Education (NAfME), and Pi Kappa Lambda and Kappa Kappa Psi as an honorary member.

Threinen is a native of Minnesota and a graduate of the University of Minnesota-Twin Cities (1999), Northwestern University in Evanston, Illinois (2004), and the University of Michigan in Ann Arbor, Michigan (2007). She and her family live in a suburb outside of Minneapolis, Minnesota.

Scotty Barnhart is an internationally acclaimed Jazz trumpeter, composer, arranger, educator, author, and is the Director of The Legendary Count Basie Orchestra. A featured trumpet soloist with the orchestra for over twenty years, he's a two-time Grammy Award winner, appears on three critically acclaimed recordings with pianist Marcus Roberts, and over fifteen others with artists as diverse as Tony Bennett, Diana Krall, Ray Charles, and Tito Puente. Acknowledged as an authority on the history of Jazz trumpet, he has given two keynote lecture-demonstrations at The International Trumpet Guild Conference and continues to give lectures and seminars at universities in South America, Japan, China, Europe, South Africa, and all across the United States. Hal Leonard published his groundbreaking book, *The World of Jazz Trumpet – A Comprehensive History and Practical Philosophy* worldwide in December 2005 to rave reviews.

As a professor of Jazz Trumpet at Florida State University since 2003, two of Barnhart's former students won First place in the National Jazz Trumpet Competition. He was also trumpeter for the Marcus Roberts Quintet in the late 80s and early 90s and garnered critical acclaim for his playing and sound of which The New York Times wrote: "Barnhart bears watching... laid out assured melodic lines in a singing, silvery tone." He has also performed or recorded with Frank Sinatra, Wynton Marsalis, Herbie Hancock, Quincy Jones, The Duke Ellington Orchestra, Ray Brown, Take 6, Lena Horne, Max Roach, Nat Adderley, Aretha Franklin, Lalo Schifrin, Natalie Cole, Jane Monheit, Jon Hendricks, Hank Jones, Freddie Hubbard, Clark Terry, Nancy Wilson, George Benson, and Barbara Streisand among others. Additionally, Barnhart has been featured in the Asian Wall Street Journal, performed at The Academy Awards, and is in demand as a soloist and lecturer on jazz history. In April of 2008, Unity Music signed Barnhart to his first recording contract as a leader and released his long anticipated debut CD, *Say It Plain*, to critical acclaim on May 19, 2009. Of *Say It Plain*, Bill Cosby states "Scotty Barnhart's soulful work combines a mastery of tradition with vibrant originality. I love it!" An unprecedented lineup of musicians appeared with Barnhart on his solo recording, including Wynton Marsalis, Clark Terry, Ellis Marsalis, Marcus Roberts, Herlin Riley, Todd Williams, Leon Anderson, Jr., Bill Peterson, and Rodney Jordan. It reached #3 on the Jazz Charts. A graduate of Florida A&M University with a degree in Music Education, he is profiled in the book *Trumpet Kings*, which places him with the most important Jazz trumpeters in history, from Louis Armstrong to Miles Davis and others.

His choirs have toured China, South Africa, and the United

States and have appeared at national and regional conferences.

Cheryl Nichols has been making music with friends of all ages for fifty years. She has been a collaborative pianist with countless ensembles and soloists, and is an active member of the American Choral Directors Association. Serving ACDA, Cheryl has accompanied ACDA's Missouri All State high school choir for 25 years. Ms. Nichols holds degrees from the University of Missouri-Columbia, and is a retired vocal music educator of 37 years. Cheryl is currently serving Columbia College as collaborative staff pianist and Peace United Church of Christ as director of choir and music in her hometown of Hartsburg, Missouri.
