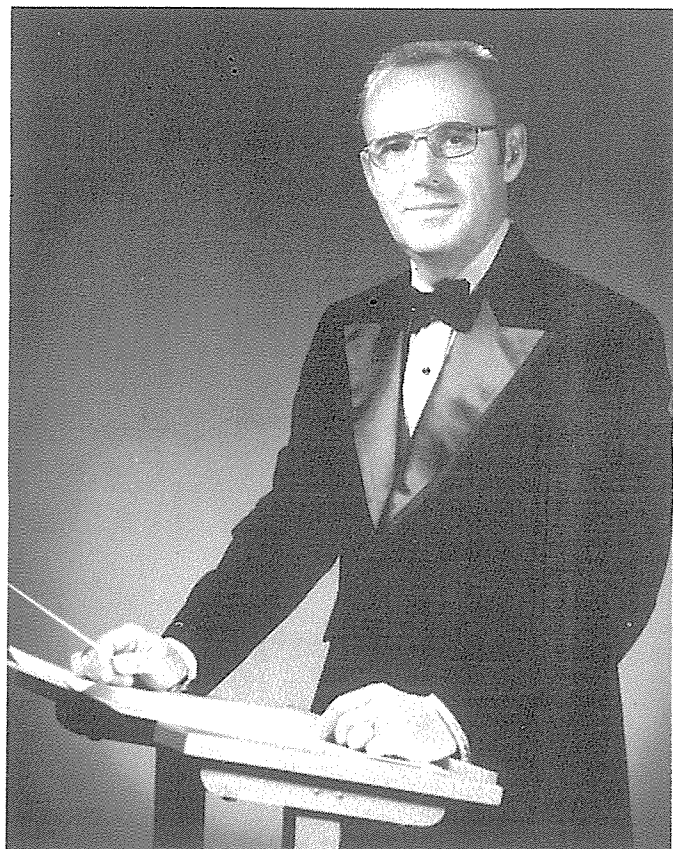

MR. DEAN KILLION

Mr. Dean Killion is Professor of Music and Director of Bands at Texas Tech University, Lubbock, Texas. He has been a member of the Texas Tech University music faculty since 1959, and previously was Director of Bands at Fresno State College, California. Earlier, Mr. Killion taught at the University of Nebraska where he was Instructor of trumpet and assisted with the work of the University of Nebraska bands.

From 1951 to 1955 Mr. Killion was Music Supervisor and Director of Instrumental Music in the Sidney, Nebraska, Public Schools.

Mr. Killion received his Bachelor of Music and Master of Music degrees from the University of Nebraska, and has done post-graduate study at the State University of Iowa. He was honored as an Outstanding Alumnus at the University of Nebraska in 1974, and was presented the "Action Award" from the Texas Tech Museum Association for outstanding cultural achievement in Lubbock.

In addition to the University bands, Mr. Killion is director of the Lubbock Municipal Band, and was instrumental in its organization. He is a member of the American Bandmasters Association, the College Band Directors Association, the National Band Directors Association, the Texas Music Educators Association, and the Texas Bandmasters Association. He has served as a clinician, director, and adjudicator throughout the United States, Canada, and Mexico.
