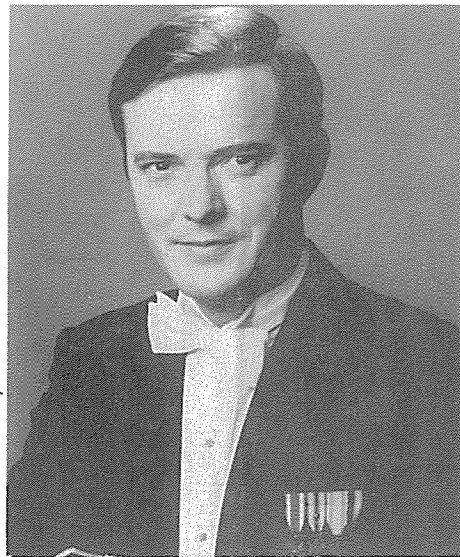

MAJOR JAMES M. BANKHEAD

COMMANDER/CONDUCTOR

Major James M. Bankhead, Commander and Conductor of The United States Air Force Band, is from Providence, Utah. He received his Bachelor of Music degree from Utah State University, Master of Arts degree from Central Michigan University and a Doctor of Musical Arts degree from The Catholic University of America in Washington, D.C.

In 1969, Major Bankhead joined the Air Force as an oboist and was commissioned in 1970. He has served as Deputy Commander of the Air Force Academy Band, Colorado Springs, Colorado; Commander of the 724th Air Force Band, McChord Air Force Base in Tacoma, Washington; and as Deputy Chief and Chief of Air Force Bands and Music Branch at the Pentagon. Prior to his present appointment, Major Bankhead served as the Deputy Commander and Assistant Conductor of The United States Air Force Band of Washington, D.C.

On March 7, 1986, Major Bankhead was officially inducted into the American Bandmasters Association. This prestigious organization consists of prominent bandleaders, composers and arrangers from all levels of the music profession, and has had a long history of providing outstanding service to the international music world.

Major Bankhead was a distinguished graduate from Officer Training School and was commissioned in April, 1970. He has been awarded the Meritorious Service Medal with one oak leaf cluster, Air Force Commendation Medal with one oak leaf cluster and Air Force Achievement Medal.
