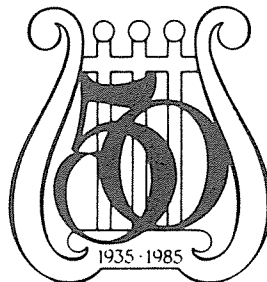

About the Conductor

Frank Mantooth is currently active as a pianist, composer, arranger, clinician and educator residing in Oak Park, Illinois. Frank's first album for the Optimism label, "Suite Tooth", has been met with critical acclaim including a four-star review in the April, 1990 Down Beat, and Grammy nominations in three categories.

The release of his second album (Persevere) on the Optimism label featuring Pete Christlieb and Clark Terry has also been met with a glowing endorsement by the Jazz Times. As an author, Frank has recently published "The Best Chord Changes for the 'World's Greatest Standards'", Vols. 1 and 2 for Hal Leonard Publishing Corp. This is in addition to over 100 works for com- bo and jazz ensemble which have been published since 1978.

Recent writing commissions have come from Illinois Music Educators Association, The Jazz Members Big Band, The Army Blues, Doc Severinsen, Bobby Shew, Ramsey Lewis, saxophonist Pete Christlieb, and drummer/bandleader Louie Bellson.

Upcoming performances will be in collaboration with jazz artists Bob Bowmen, Kim Park, Ed Shaughmessy, Denis DiBlasio, Milt Hinton, Pat LaBarbera, and Vincent diMartino.

About the Conductor

Ray E. Cramer is Department Chairman and Director of Bands at Indiana University, Bloomington, Indiana.

Under Mr. Cramer's leadership the Indiana University Symphonic Band has earned an international reputation for outstanding performances. They have performed for the ABA Convention, the American Bandmasters Association/Japan Bandmasters Association joint convention, the MENC National Convention, and other regional and state conventions.

Mr. Cramer is currently serving as National President of the College Band Directors National Association and in the past has served as president of the Indiana Bandmasters Association, the North Central Division of CBDNA, and the Big Ten Band Directors Association. He is a member of ABA, CBDNA, NBA WASBE, MENC, IMEA, IBA, CIDA, and is affiliated with Phi Mu Alpha Sinfonia, Kappa Kappa Psi (Distinguished Service to Music Award, 1988; Bohumil Makovsky Memorial Award, 1991), Tau Beta Sigma, Phi Kappa Delta, Phi Beta Mu (International Assembly, Outstanding Bandmaster Award, 1988).

Mr. Cramer's solid musicianship, broad knowledge of traditional and contemporary wind literature and dynamic personality keeps him in constant demand as a guest conductor/clinician throughout the United States. He recently spent a semester conducting the Musashino Academia of Music Wind Ensemble in Tokyo, Japan.

About The Conductor

Douglas R. McEwen holds a bachelor's degree from Bowling Green State University, a master's degree from Indiana University and a doctorate from the University of Northern Colorado. Dr. McEwen's background is rich in the areas of both teaching and performance. He began his teaching and conducting career in California; first in the public schools and for four years at LaVerene College. Moving to Colorado, he was Director of Choral Activities at the University of Northern Colorado for three years, followed by six years in the same capacity at the University of New Mexico, Albuquerque.

For twenty years as Director of Choirs at Arizona State University, Tempe, Dr. McEwen guided students through choral experiences from the undergraduate through the doctoral levels. Recently retired, he was appointed Professor Emeritus of Music on the ASU faculty.

In wide demand as conductor and choral clinician, Dr. McEwen has in recent years conducted more than fifty all-state choirs and many more festival choruses from coast to coast. He has served as assistant director of the Meadowbrook Choral Institute and has appeared as guest conductor with the Minnesota Symphony and the Phoenix Symphony. As assistant conductor and soloist, he toured the Middle East and Europe with the Roger Wagner Chorale. For two years he served as Director of Choral Masterworks for the International Youth and Music Festival in Vienna, Austria. He is a past president of the Western Division of the American Choral Directors Association.
