About the Conductor

**Craig Jessop** has been music director of the Mormon Tabernacle Choir since 1999. Previously, he served as the Choir’s associate director from 1995 to 1999, and was a member of the Choir for four years during college. His university studies have been at Utah State and BYU and his doctorate in musical arts at Stanford. He was recruited by the United States Air Force music programs to conduct the U.S. Singing Sergeants and served as commander and conductor of the Band of the United States Air Forces in Europe and the Air Combat Heartland of America Band. Touring, recording and performing around the world and in all 50 states for presidents, kings, and heads of state prepared him well for his present job. He sang with the Robert Shaw Festival Singers, which included performing with its composer-conductor in concerts throughout Europe and at Carnegie Hall. Recordings of the Mormon Tabernacle choir’s have earned two platinum and five gold albums, including a Grammy Award-winning rendition of “Battle Hymn of the Republic.” The choir has recorded with some of the world’s great orchestras, including the Philadelphia Orchestra, the New York Philharmonic Orchestra and the Jerusalem Symphony Orchestra.

**Jan K. Kraybill** is the Principal Organist and Director of Music at Community of Christ Headquarters in Independence, Missouri. She holds degrees in music education and piano performance from Kansas State University and a DMA in organ performance from the Conservatory of Music, University of Missouri at Kansas City. Dr. Kraybill performs regularly as an organist, pianist and harpsichordist, and has appeared as a recitalist and lecturer at regional and national musicians’ conventions in the United States and Canada. She has performed in Russia and Poland, and has undertaken multiple tours of the United Kingdom which have included solo performances on historic organs, including St. Paul’s Cathedral in London.

**Deborah Wells Clark**, harpist, is presently Principal Harpist and Assistant Personnel Manager with the Kansas City Symphony. She is teaching in the harp at the University of Missouri-Kansas City. Mrs. Clark has twice appeared as soloist with the Kansas City Symphony and is a founding member of Summerfest. Mrs. Clark has also been the harpist for the Utah Festival Opera Company, the Lake George Opera Festival and the Crested Butte Music Festival. In addition, she has performed throughout the Midwest, East Coast, Europe, and in Singapore.

**Jon-Marc Donald**, percussionist, is the Percussion Area Head and Director of the CrossPulse Ethnic Drum Ensemble at Music/Arts Institute®. He holds B.M and M.M. degrees from UMKC and has completed coursework for his DMA in Percussion Performance from the University of Iowa. He is an active clinician and performer in the Kansas City Metro Area specializing in the synthesis of electronic and acoustic music. Jon has performed in Europe, America and French Polynesia.

About the Conductor

Michael Philip Mossman has been a professional musician and active in the international scene since the age of 17. He has performed with a great variety of jazz stylists, including Roscoe Mitchell (avant garde), Dizzy Gillespie (bebop), Gerry Mulligan (cool), Lionel Hampton and Count Basie (swing), Art Blakey’s Jazz Messengers and the Horace Silver Quintet (hardbop) and the Machito Orchestra (Afro-Cuban Jazz). He played lead trumpet with theToshiko Akiyoshi Jazz Orchestra, led the group Out of the Blue (OTB) for Blue Note Records, and has performed and recorded with the Latin jazz bands of Michel Camilo, Mario Bauza, Ray Barretto and Eddie Palmieri among others. As an arranger, he has written for the Philadelphia Orchestra, the Joe Henderson Big Band, the Mingus Big Band, the Count Basie Orchestra, Tito Puente, Slide Hampton’s Jazz Masters, and radio orchestras throughout Europe. He composed a 40 minute ballet for the Chicago Jazz Orchestra and Deeply Rooted Dance Company titled “Beneath the Mask,” along with his wife, film choreographer Mayte Vicens. He is currently the lead trumpet with Jazz at Lincoln Center’s Afro-Latin Jazz Orchestra and is a professor at the Aaron Copland School of Music at Queens College in New York. Michael Philip Mossman is proud to be associated with the Yamaha Corporation.

About the Commissioned Work

“I Mean MO” is an original swing chart by Antonio García, the Director of Jazz Studies at Virginia Commonwealth University and the director of the 2007 Missouri All-State Jazz Band. Excerpts of the piece served as the required audition etudes for entry into the band. Based on the chord progression to Thelonious Monk’s composition “I Mean You,” the music incorporates Monk’s penchant for occasional straight eighth notes and whole-tone scales, plus 20 musical references to 16 different Monk tunes. The title reflects both the home state of the premiering band and the name of the composer whose chord progression frames the new work.

Paul Phillips, conductor

About the Conductor

Paul Phillips was appointed to the faculty of the Meadows School of the Arts at Southern Methodist University in Dallas in 1996 where he serves as Professor of Music, Music Director of the Meadows Symphony Orchestra, and Chair of the Department of Conducting and Ensembles. Before joining the faculty of the Meadows School, Dr. Phillips served for twelve years as Music Director of the Eastern Connecticut Symphony Orchestra (New London) and was only the third conductor to hold that position in the orchestra’s fifty year history. While in Connecticut, Dr. Phillips was also Professor of Music at the University of Connecticut, where he served as Chair of Music and Music Director of the University of Connecticut Symphony Orchestra.

A native of Texas, Dr. Phillips completed undergraduate studies at Southern Methodist University and received his Master of Arts and Doctor of Musical Arts Degrees from the Eastman School of Music in Rochester, New York. In 1980 Dr. Phillips was appointed Assistant Conductor of the Atlanta Symphony Orchestra (Robert Shaw, Music Director). He was selected for that position after winning an invitational only competition sponsored by the orchestra.

Dr. Phillips has made a number of recordings of music of living composers on the Novisse, Grenadilla Gasparo and Centaur labels including a world premiere compact disc featuring works of Sydney Hodkinson performed by the Eastern Connecticut Symphony with soprano Renee Fleming, star of the Metropolitan Opera. He recently conducted the world premiere performance of Thomas Sleeper’s Symphony No. 1.

Widely recognized as an outstanding collaborative artist, Paul Phillips has performed with noted soloists such as Itzak Perlman, Misha Dichter and James Galway. In 1996, his achievements with the Eastern Connecticut Symphony were recognized by critics who wrote that he was “...one of the most influential musicians in Connecticut”. His performances with the Meadows Symphony Orchestra in Dallas have received consistent and enthusiastic critical acclaim. As a teacher he continues to work with gifted young orchestral musicians and conductors at the Meadows School of the Arts at SMU and at music festivals.

About the Composer

John E. Cheetham, Professor Emeritus of Music Theory and Composition at the University of Missouri-Columbia was born in Taos, New Mexico in 1939. He received his Bachelor and Masters degrees from the University of New Mexico in 1962 and 1965, and a Doctor of Musical Arts in Composition from the University of Washington in 1969.

During his tenure at Missouri University from 1969 to 2000, he wrote compositions for virtually all media, and his works have been widely performed in the United States and abroad. Much of his music has been published commercially since 2001 through his own publishing firm, BoonesLick Press. Recordings of many of his works are available on Crystal, Concord, Mark, Pro-Arte, Summit, and NPR Classic labels. In addition, Dr. Cheetham has received numerous commissions including those from the Kentucky Derby Museum, Texas Tech University, the Atlanta Symphony Brass Quintet, Belhaven College, the Central Oklahoma Directors Association, University of Southern Mississippi Southern Chorale, the Summit Brass, the Air Force Band of the Midwest, and the Central Oregon Symphony Association (Bend, OR), as well as from several individual soloists. He has written several commemorative pieces, including a work in memory of the Oklahoma City bombing victims, a piece celebrating the sesquicentennial anniversary of the University of Missouri, works celebrating the lives of former teachers, and an overture for the opening of the 14th International Music Festival in Belem, Brazil.

Although the majority of his commissions are for adult organizations, Dr. Cheetham enjoys the opportunity of writing accessible compositions at the appropriate difficulty level for the younger groups. Previous compositions for youth groups include works for the Missouri All-State String Orchestra (*Three Bingham’s*) and the Jefferson City Missouri High School String Orchestra (*Three Bentons*). Dr. Cheetham is a member of ASCAP and has received ASCAP Special Awards yearly since 1988. In 1992 he won the Abraham Frost Prize in Composition and has also been the recipient of a Centennial Distinguished Alumni Award from the University of New Mexico.
