About the Conductor

Dr. Robert B. Gregg is the Director of Graduate Studies for the School of Music and the Orchestra Director at Belmont University. He has been a member of the Belmont faculty since 1984. Dr. Gregg teaches courses in conducting, music education, music literature, and music history. Dr. Gregg received a Ph.D. in College Teaching and a Master of Music Education from the University of North Texas, and a Bachelor of Music Education from Oklahoma Baptist University. Prior to his tenure at Belmont, Dr. Gregg was Assistant to the Dean of the School of Music at the University of North Texas. While at North Texas, he also served as the Assistant Conductor of Orchestras under Maestro Anshel Brusilow and Brass Choir Conductor. Dr. Gregg was also a band director in Bowlegs, OK and choir director of St. Paul’s United Methodist Church in Shawnee, OK. Dr. Gregg has been a guest conductor with the Nashville Symphony, the University of Central Florida Orchestra, the Tennessee Techno-logical University Orchestra, and the Tennessee Governor’s School of the Arts Orchestra.

Kirt N. Mosier, composer
About the Composer

Kirt N. Mosier is currently in his twenty third year of teaching. Mr. Mosier is presently teaching for the Lee’s Summit R-7 School District. He is the director of orchestras at Lee’s Summit West High School. Prior to his teaching position with the R-7 school district, Mr. Mosier taught for the Raytown C-2 School District. During his nine years of teaching for the Raytown C-2 district, Mr. Mosier was the director of orchestras at Raytown South High School, and at Raytown South Middle School. Mr. Mosier has been an adjunct professor for Baker University where he taught music history. Mr. Mosier is currently an adjunct professor for the University of Missouri at Kansas City where he teaches arranging for music education and masters degree candidates. Mr. Mosier holds a BME degree from the University of Missouri at Kansas City, as well as a Masters of Music in composition from the same institution. Mr. Mosier is an active clinician and adjudicator throughout the Midwest and southern regions of the United States. Mr. Mosier is also a composer and has had works featured at the Midwest International Band and Orchestra Clinic. Mr. Mosier has over 60 published works for orchestra. His piece *Baltic Dance* won the 1993 National School Orchestra Association composition contest and his piece *American Reel* won the 2004 Merle J. Isaac national composition contest. In addition to *Run!*, Mr. Mosier has been commissioned by the Missouri chapter of ASTA to write the All-State Orchestra pieces, *Revelation* and *Out of Adullum*.

Brad Holmes - Conductor

About the Conductor

Brad Holmes conducts the University Choir and is the Director of Choir Programs at Millikin University in Decatur, Illinois. Dr. Holmes received the M.M. degree in conducting from the University of New Mexico and the D.M.A. degree in choral music from Arizona State University. Previous postings range from Choral Director for the New Mexico Symphony Orchestra to church choir positions; from public school teaching to conducting light opera in civic theatres. Prior to coming to Millikin, Dr. Holmes was Associate Director of Choirs at Luther College in Decorah, Iowa.

Choirs under Brad Holmes’ direction have sung in every state but Alaska (and in thirty-three countries). In 2000 he was a Visiting Fellow at Cambridge University working primarily with the Choir of Clare College. He has returned to England for guest-conducting engagements in Windsor and Manchester. Other invitations include engagements in the Far East conducting choirs from Japan, Korea, China and the Philippines. Dr. Holmes’ domestic guest-conducting schedule has included All-State, regional ACDA Honor Choirs, District festivals and church music clinics throughout the United States.

In his eighteen years at Millikin University, Dr. Holmes has overseen the growth of the choral program to five traditional choirs and a variety of smaller vocal ensembles involving 300 singers and eight staff. The Millikin University Choir has toured internationally to Norway, Russia, Mexico, Dominican Republic, Haiti, Puerto Rico, China, Taiwan and England. Under Dr. Holmes’ direction, the choir has produced four CDs on Millikin’s First Step Recording label. In the past decade, the choir has performed for three regional conventions of the American Choral Directors Association (ACDA). Their recent performance before the National Convention of ACDA in Miami garnered new attention on the choir’s approach to tonal variety.

Dr. Holmes responsibilities at Millikin include teaching Choral Techniques and Conducting. He is artistic director for Millikin’s *Christmas Vespers*, which attracts 7,000 people annually. He frequently contributes arrangements to First Step Publishing, Millikin’s student-run publishing house. His arrangements have also been published by Santa Barbara Music Press.

About the Conductor

Bob Lark serves as the Director of Jazz Studies at DePaul University in Chicago, Illinois, where he directs the university Jazz Ensemble and the Phil Woods Ensemble, teaches jazz trumpet and courses in jazz pedagogy and jazz style. Under his direction the DePaul University Jazz Ensemble has produced several Outstanding Performance Awards from the Jazz Educators Journal, Down Beat and Jazz Times magazines, and has recorded albums with legendary jazz artists Phil Woods, Clark Terry, Louie Bellson, Bob Brookmeyer, Tom Harrell, Jim McNeely, Frank Wess, Slide Hampton, Bobby Shew, and Chicago Symphony Orchestra members Charles Vernon and John Bruce Yeh. Bob is an active clinician, soloist and guest conductor, and is the past-president of the Illinois Unit of the International Association for Jazz Education, has chaired the International Trumpet Guild jazz improvisation competition, served as the host for the Carmine Caruso International Jazz Trumpet Solo Competition, and throughout the 1990’s directed the Midwest GRAMMY High School Jazz Band. He holds a Doctor of Musical Arts degree in performance from the University of North Texas, having earlier earned a Master’s degree from that school and a Bachelor of Music Education degree from The Ohio State University.

About the Commissioned Work

“Un Calor Seco (A Dry Heat)” is an original mambo chart by Michael Kocour, the Director of Jazz Studies at Arizona State University and the director of the 2009 Missouri All-State Jazz Band. The great big band arrangements performed by Latin Jazz giants such as Dizzy Gillespie, Tito Puente, Eddie Palmieri, and Chico O’Farrill provided the inspiration for this piece. Typical of the style, it is a brassy high-energy mambo chart. Highlights include some challenging ensemble passages as well as solos from the saxophone and trumpet sections. Careful research went into the creation of the rhythm section parts to insure that the band plays with an authentic Afro-Cuban groove. Dr. Andrew Boysen, Jr. – Conductor

About the Conductor

Andrew Boysen, Jr. is presently an associate professor in the music department at the University of New Hampshire, where he conducts the wind symphony and teaches conducting, composition and orchestration. Previously, Boysen served as an assistant professor and Acting Associate Director of Bands at Indiana State University, where he directed the Marching Sycamores, conducted the symphonic band and taught in the music education department. Prior to that appointment, he was the Director of Bands at Cary-Grove (IL) High School and was the music director and conductor of the Deerfield Community Concert Band. He remains active as a guest conductor and clinician, appearing with high school, university and festival ensembles across the United States, Great Britain, and Australia. Boysen earned his Doctor of Musical Arts degree in wind conducting at the Eastman School of Music, where he served as conductor of the Eastman Wind Orchestra and assistant conductor of the Eastman Wind Ensemble. He received his Master of Music degree in wind conducting from Northwestern University in 1993 and his Bachelor of Music degree in music education and music composition from the University of Iowa in 1991. He maintains an active schedule as a composer, receiving commissions from the Herbert Hoover Presidential Library, the Cedar Rapids Metropolitan Orchestra Festival, the Iowa All-State Band, the Rhode Island All-State Band, the Nebraska Bandmasters Association, and many university and high school concert bands across the United States. Boysen won the International Horn Society Composition contest in 2000, the University of Iowa Honors Composition Prize in 1991 and has twice won the Claude T. Smith Memorial Band Composition Contest, in 1991 for *I Am*, and in 1994 for *Ovations*.
